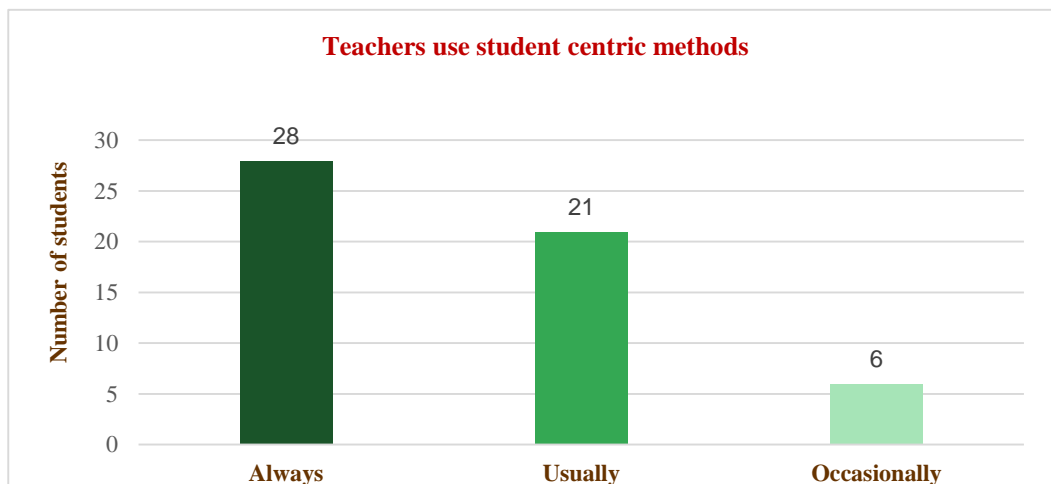
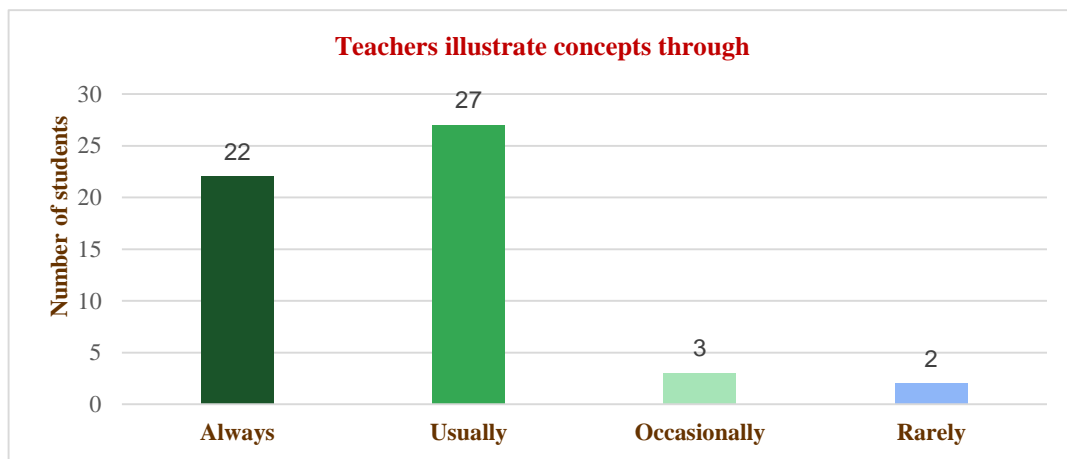
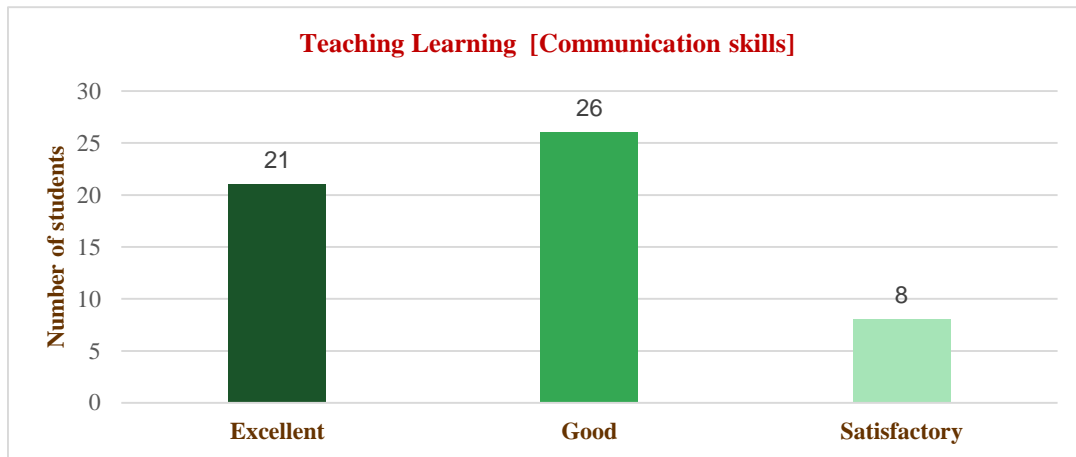
Student Satisfaction Survey 2020

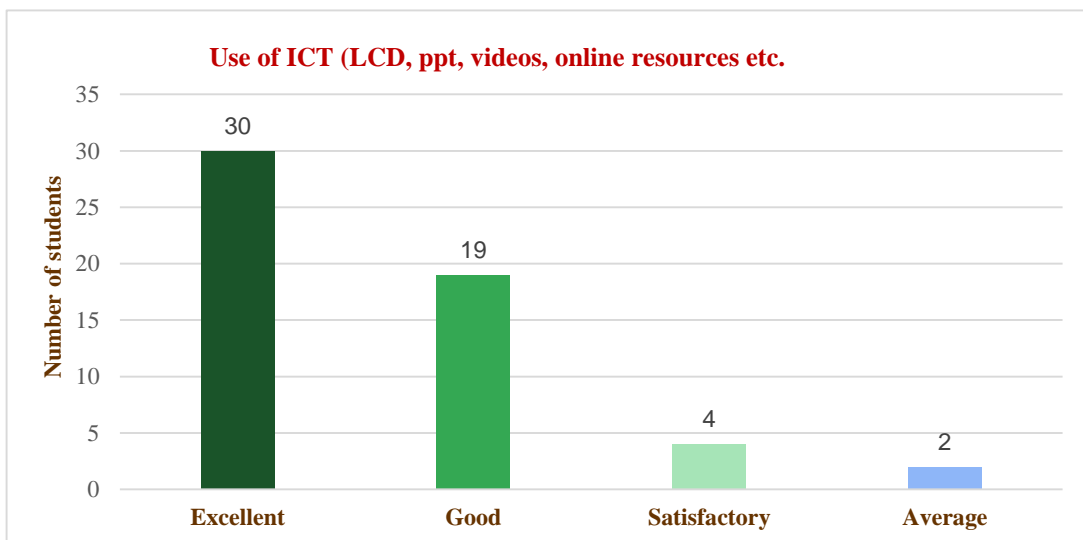
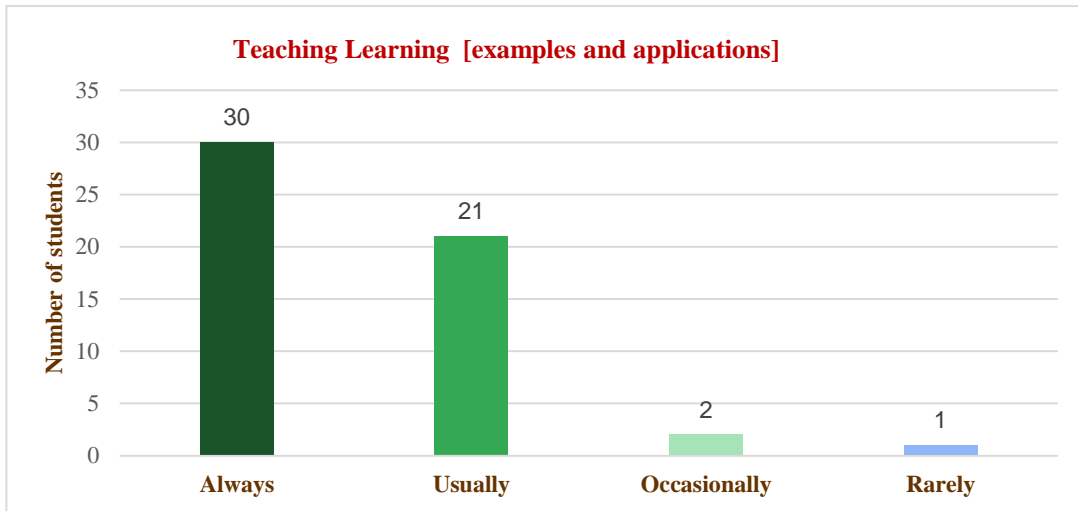
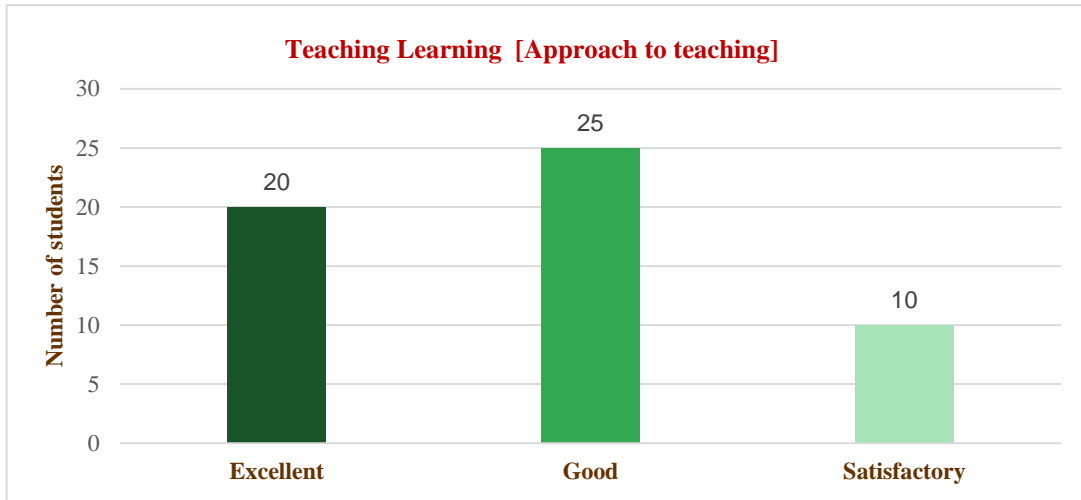

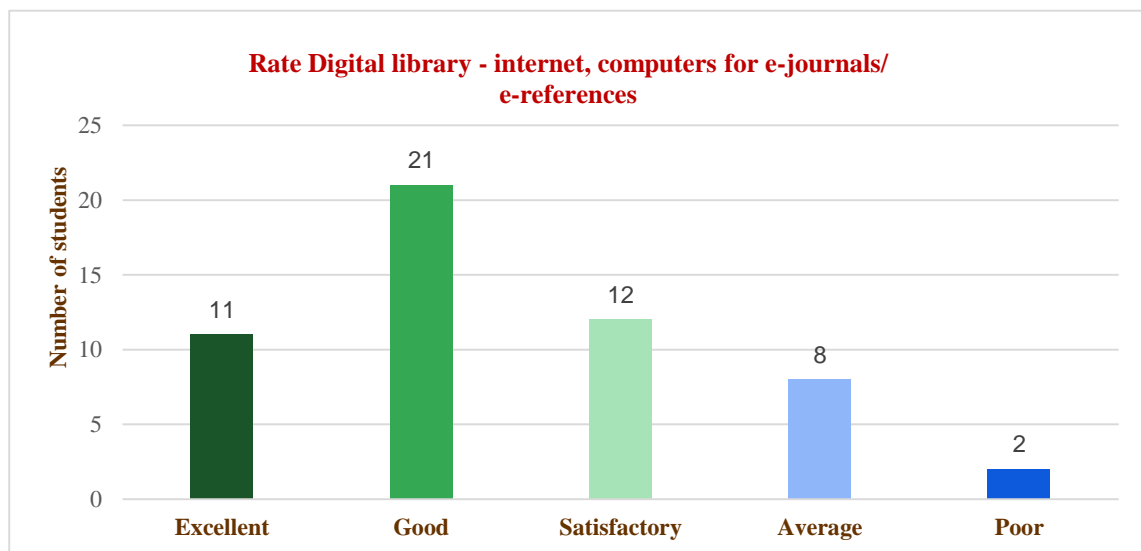
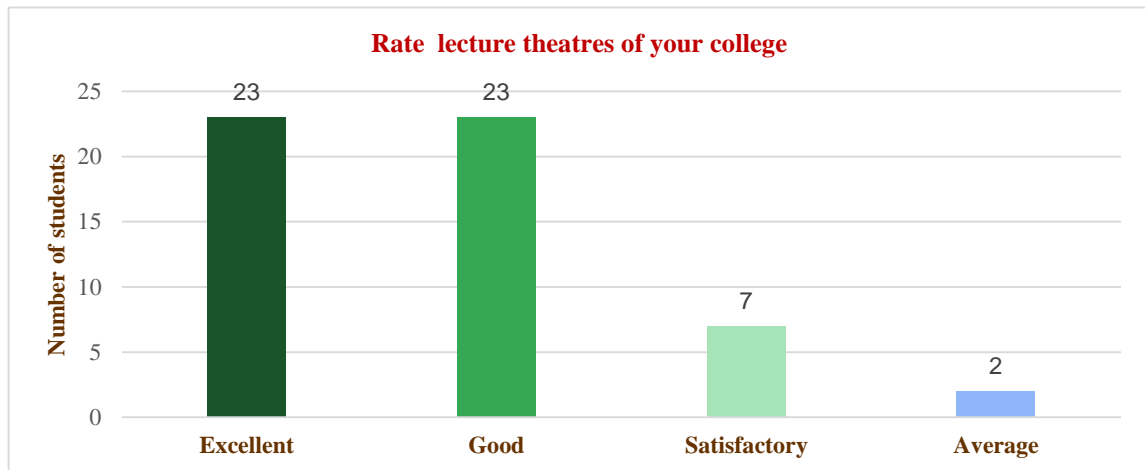
Students observations / suggestions to improve the overall teaching- learning experience in the institution is as below:

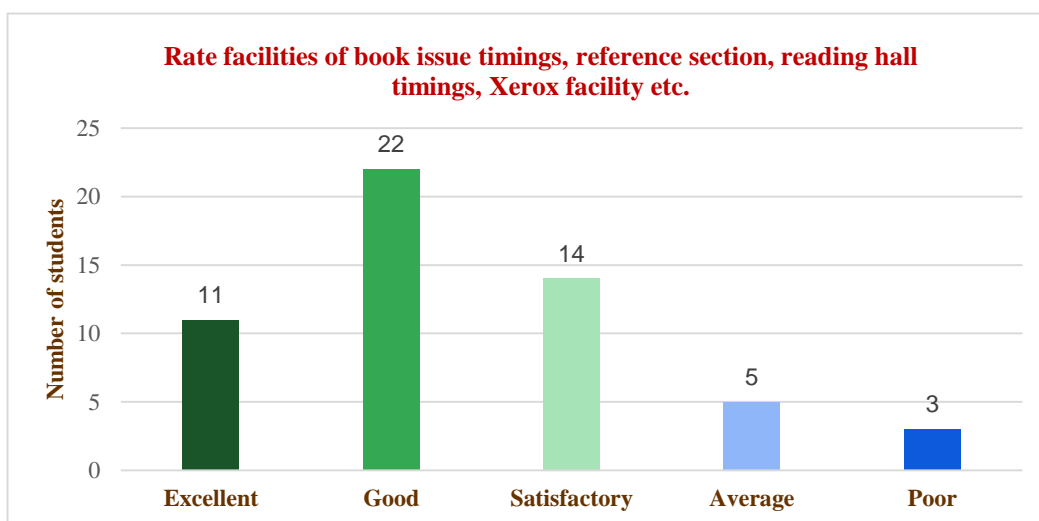
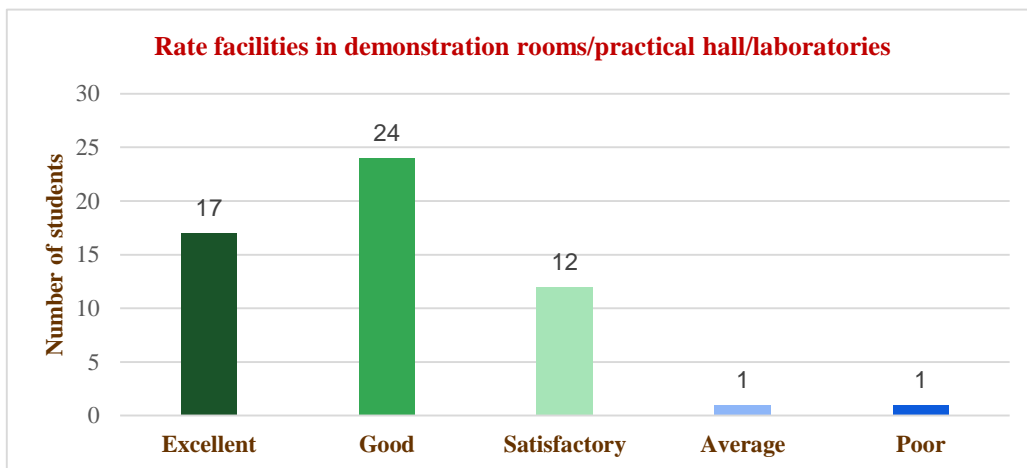
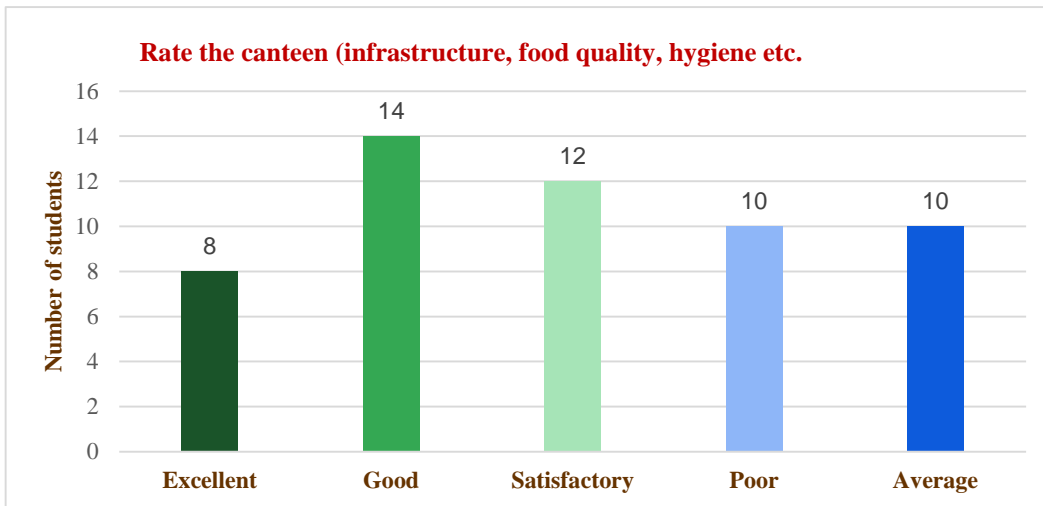
- Students wished for more field experience and hands on training with certain courses such as ‘Rescue and Rehabilitation’, exposure to new analytical software, using a

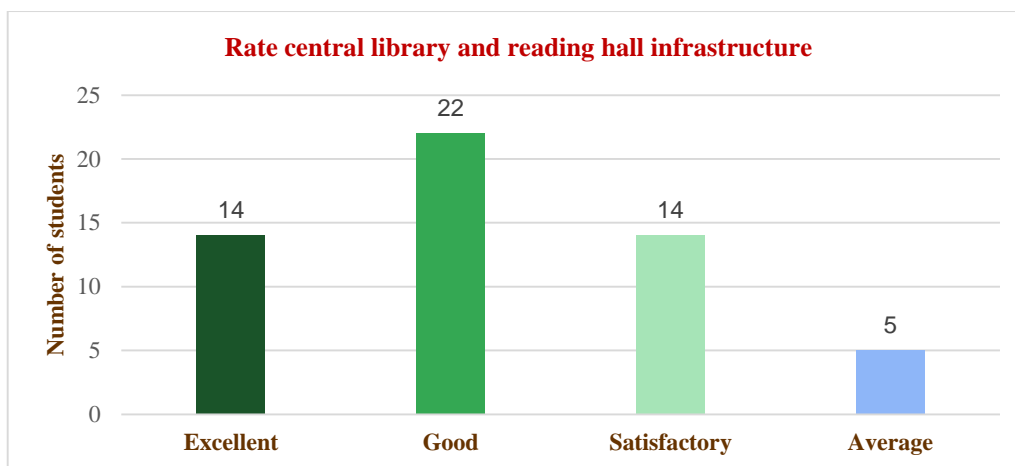
problem based approach to learning, more guest lectures to keep abreast of latest industry trends.

III. Infrastructure



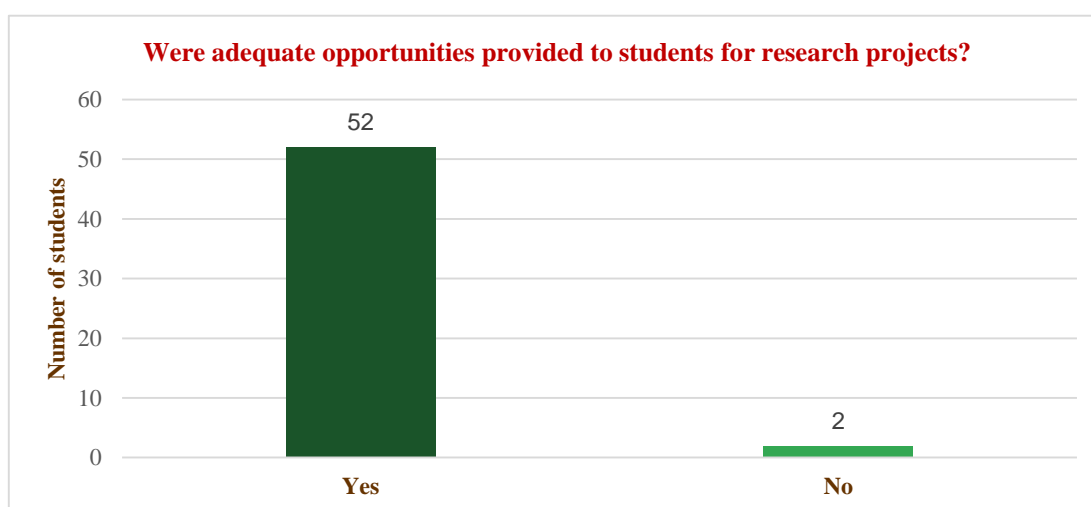


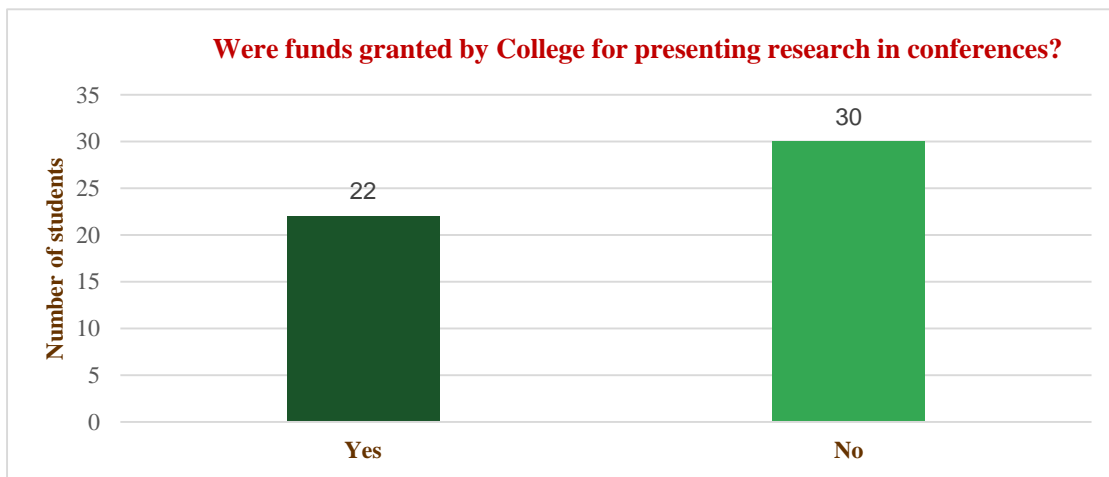
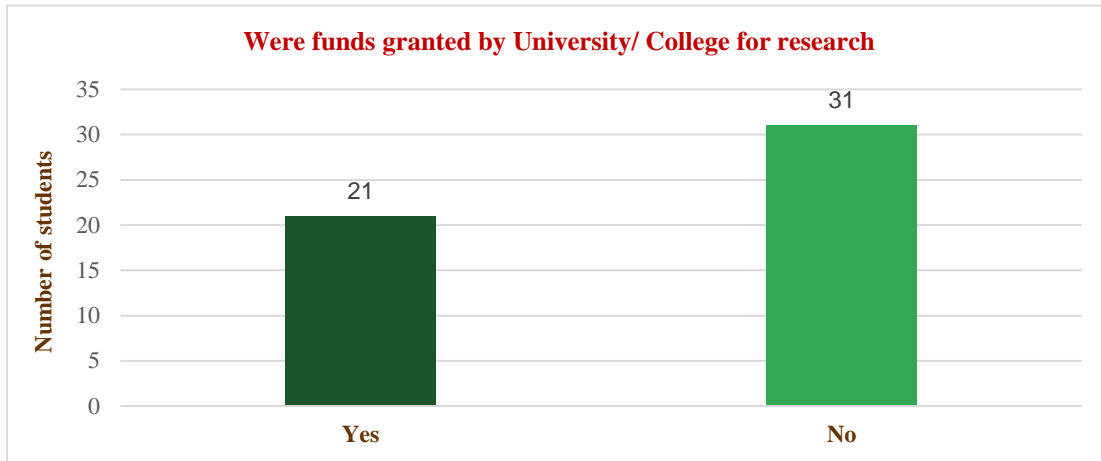


Students observations / suggestions to improve the overall infrastructure in the institution is as below:

- They felt that canteen facilities on the campus needed to be grossly improved with respect to sanitation, quality of food, healthy food and ambience.
- The library hours need to be increased alongwith number of books being issued. An e-library and library automation must be set up.
- Campus needs to have coffee vending machines, a common photocopying, printing facilities and better internet speed.
- A major concern expressed by students was the upgradation and renovation of the analytical laboratory and purchase of new laboratory equipment.
- They expressed satisfaction on the general ambience of the Institute, the teaching halls and good audio-visual facilities as well as the ecofriendly nature of the building and its environs which made them feel close to nature.

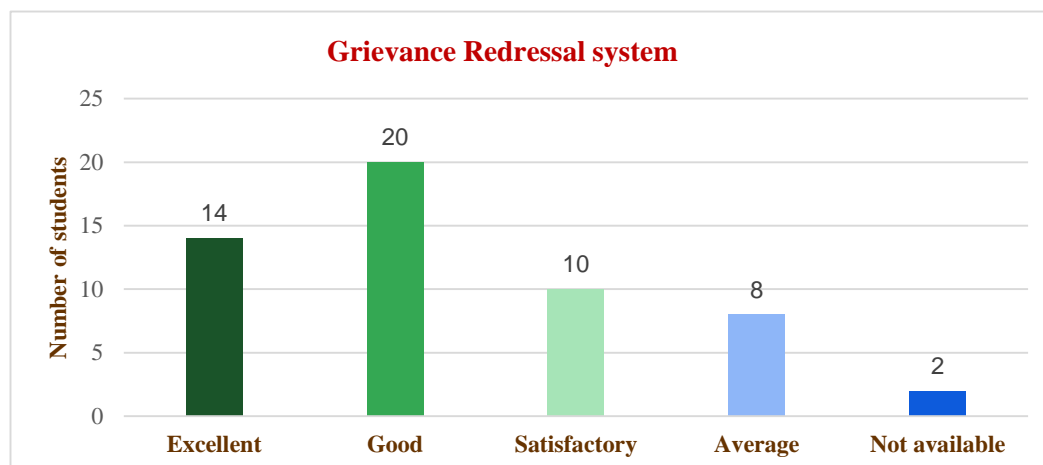
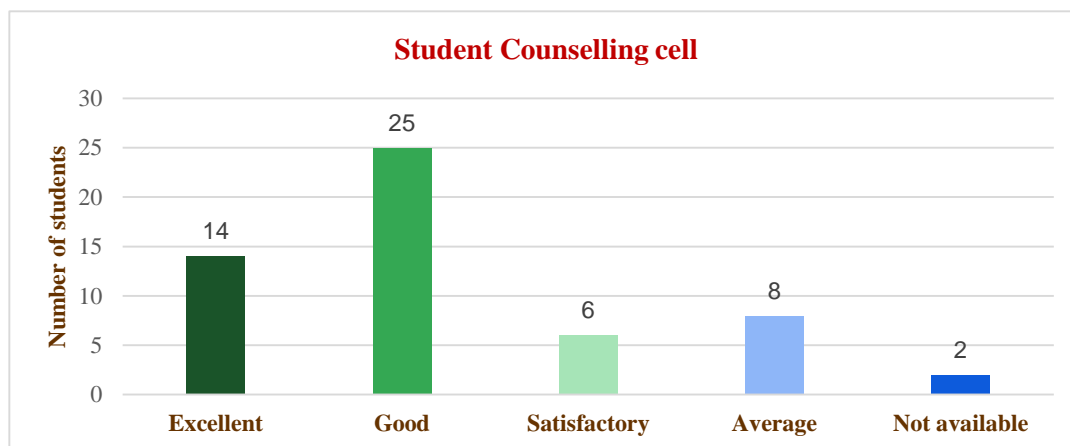
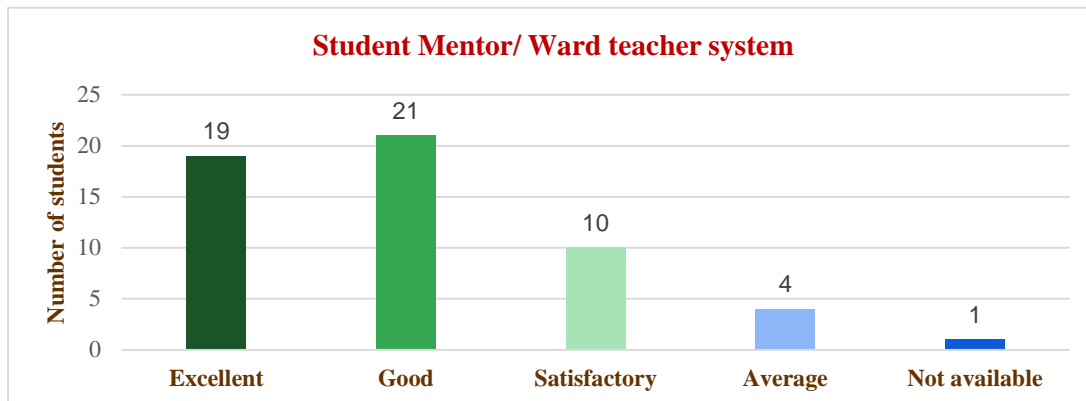


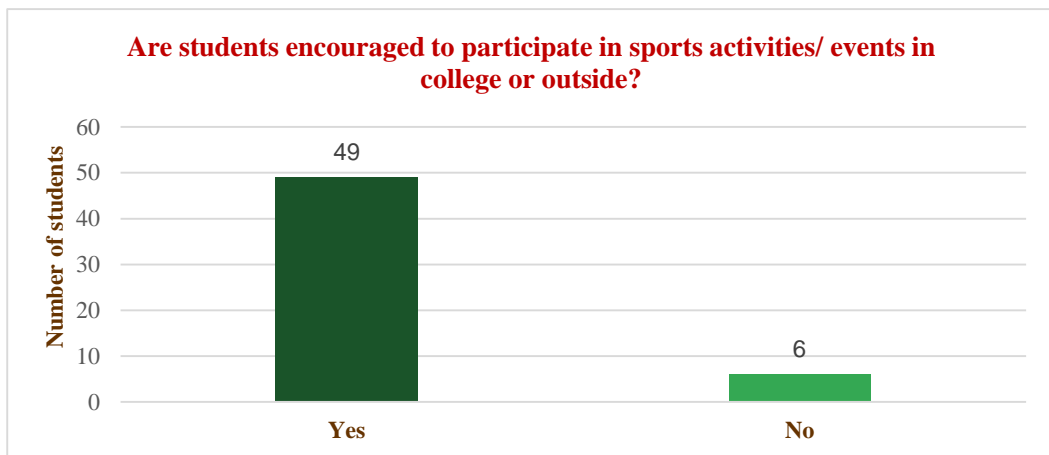
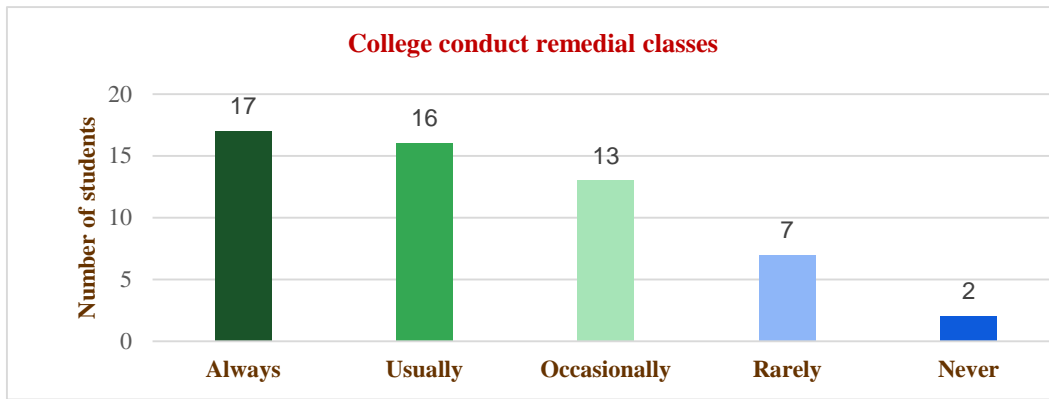
Students observations / suggestions to improve the research facilities in the institution is as below:

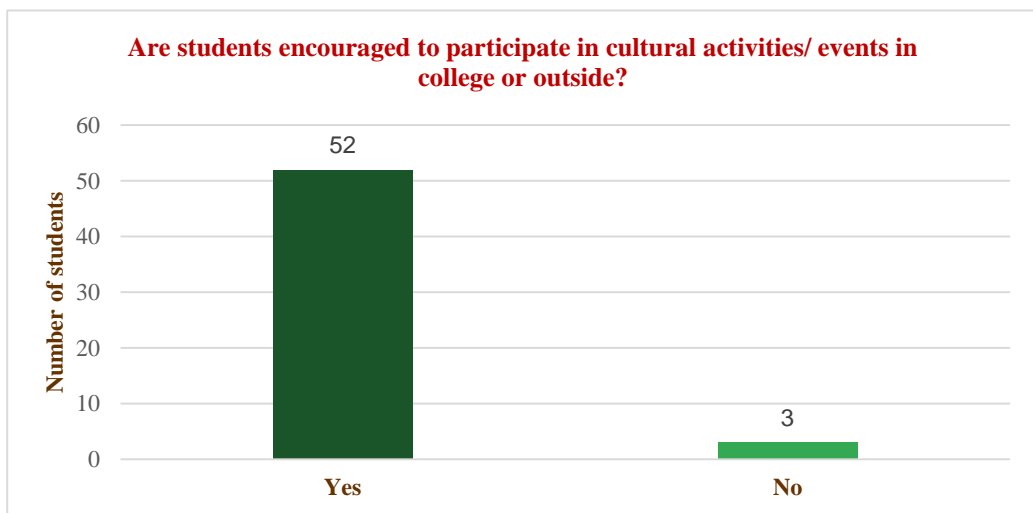

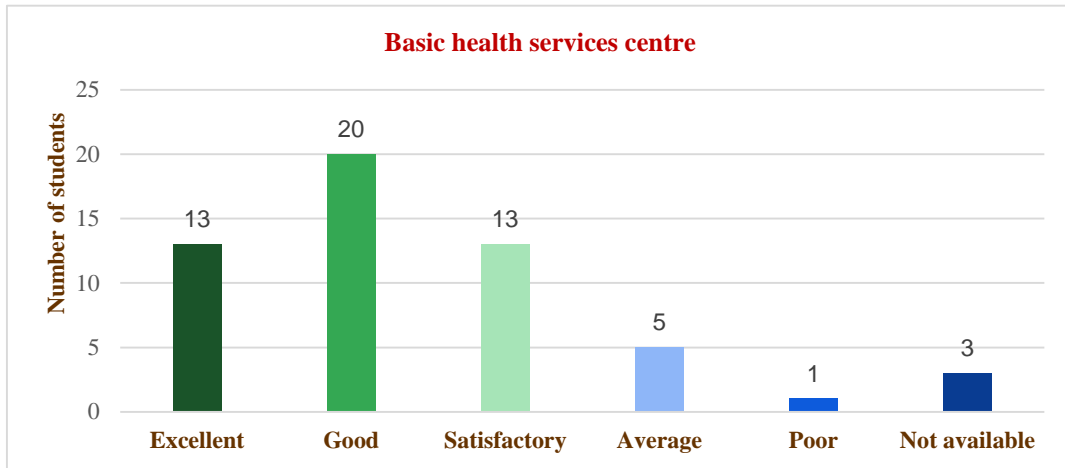
V Student Support
